"The Classical System Simplified"

November 5-6, 2011 in Palmyra, Nebraska

Come to audit: Reserve your auditing spot now! Auditing is open to anyone at any age who desires more information on classical dressage training. Anyone who wants to further their dressage knowledge or just learn more about dressage will be welcome. Cost for USDF members who pre-register is \$40/day or \$70 for both days. After October 21, the registration deadline and same day walk-in cost is \$50/day or \$90 for both days. Non-members are also invited at the cost of \$50/day or \$90 for both days.

About the clinician: Lilo Fore is an FEI "I" Judge and began her judging career in 1974. In addition to judging, she owns a successful dressage training facility located in Santa Rosa, CA, and helped to develop the USDF Instructor Certification Program. Lilo's students have gone on to become successful professionals and horses bred by her have earned Grand Champion and Champion awards in breed shows in both the US and Canada. Throughout her career, Lilo has remained involved in many educational projects including hosting clinics all over the US and South America.

REPORTS OF OFFICERS:

President: No report.

Vice President: The Annual Awards Banquet and meeting will be held November 12 at Parker's Smokehouse in Ashland, NE.

Treasurer: Diana presented the Treasurer's Report. The Main Account Balance as of August 29 was \$12,477.73. The Show Account Balance was \$3,344.44. Lisa moved to approve the Treasurer's Report; Casey seconded. Motion carried.

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES:

Membership: Karen Stricklett has requested replacement.

Discussion ensued as to the NDA membership deadline and having the handbook completed by March 1, 2012. Amy stated that she has it formatted and can easily print the handbook with minor adjustments as needed.

Suzanne Eggert needs the "bios" of people running for the NDA board so she can print it in the Contact.

Sheila Purdum is compiling the dates and places where schooling shows will be occurring in 2012.

Competitions: Discussion ensued concerning the upcoming closing date for the Schooling Show Championships to be held September 24. The closing date is September 7, and a reminder will be sent to the membership.

Preparation is being carried out for next year's show season.

Awards: Western dressage was discussed. Felice stated that she would provide a trophy this year for the high score in Western Dressage. This award will be called the Felice Rose Western Dressage High Point Trophy. There are NO restrictions as to age.

Fund Raising: Recipes for the fundraising recipe book will be solicited during the annual awards banquet. Heidi will organize the 2012 Silent Auction.
