**ENTRIES:** Entry opening date is May 2, 2011; entry closing date is June 10, 2011. One entry form for each horse/rider combination. All entries must include a copy of a current **NEGATIVE COGGINS** test. Payment in full must accompany entry form. **Make checks payable to LEC and mail with completed, signed entry form and copy of negative Coggins to Show Manager/Secretary as listed above.**

**FEES:** \$20/class; \$20 office fee.

**REFUNDS:** Refunds (less office fee) for cancellation if received before closing date. After closing date, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled. No refunds due to acts of nature.

**RIDE TIMES:** Times will be mailed or emailed to riders. If you wish to have your ride time mailed, please enclose a self-addressed and stamped envelope with your entry form. Ride times will be mailed approximately 4 days before the show.

**SHOW RULES:** All riders must check in with show office upon arrival. Current USEF and USDF tests will be used. Attire appropriate for schooling shows is expected. Show is NDA-approved and will adhere to NDA equipment requirements. Improper equipment may be grounds for elimination. Please check with Show Manager if you are unsure of equipment requirements. All riders are required to wear an ASTM/STEMI-certified helmet at all times when mounted.

**AWARDS:** Ribbons will be awarded through sixth place. In order to qualify for Champion and Reserve Champion awards, competitor must ride two tests from level, one of which must be the highest test in the level.

**STALLS AND ACCOMODATIONS:** Limited stabling will be available. Stabling is \$30/night with one bag of shavings provided. Additional shavings available at \$7.50/bag. Riders participating in the clinic Sunday will be given priority.

**CONCESSIONS:** Concessions will be available on site.

**ARENAS:** Short arena will be used for Intro and Training Level Tests 1 and 2. Warm-up will be in indoor arena or large outdoor.

**OTHER:** Lungeing in designated areas only. Management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes. All dogs must be on leashes attached to a person at all times.

# NDA BOARD MEETING MINUTES

March 2011

Vice President Lisa VanStratten called the March meeting to order at Bredeaux Pizza at 6:42pm.

Board Members Present: Gillian Howell, Donna Michelson, Lisa VanStratten, Amy Blum, Diana Spaulding, Felice Rose, Heidi Helmer.

Board Members Absent: Sydney Ash, Casey Blum.

NDA Members Present: Mike Smith, Kelli Paulson, Clay & Carol Teske brought the NDA records to the meeting so they could be delivered to Suzanne Eggert. Clay and Carol Teske did not stay for the majority of the meeting.

Gillian moved to approve the February Board Meeting minutes; Donna seconded. Motion carried.

## REPORTS OF OFFICERS:

President: No report.

Vice President: No report.

Treasurer: Diana presented the Treasurer's Report. The Main Account Balance as of March 14 was \$14,320.74. The Show Account Balance was \$4,245.26. Heidi moved to approve the Treasurer's Report; Gillian seconded. Motion carried.

Secretary: No report.

## REPORTS OF COMMITTEES:

Membership: There are 70 members as of March 14. Karen will e-mail the members from last year who have not yet renewed their memberships. She plans on working on the handbook after the Cornhusker Classic, and hopes to have it out to the members by the end of May.

Competitions: Kelli Paulson was present to discuss the addition of Western Dressage to the Schooling Show series. An article explaining Western Dressage is available through a link on the NDA website ([cowgirldressage.com](http://cowgirldressage.com)). Several people expressed interest in Western Dressage while visiting the NDA booth at the Horse Expo.

The tests for Western Dressage will be the Training and First Level USEF/USDF tests. A Western Dressage Association is being developed. USDF rules will be followed for the classes. Heidi made a motion to add Western Dressage classes to the Schooling Show Championships, Gillian seconded.

Western Dressage inclusion at the Cornhusker Classic schooling show and the LEC schooling show will be discussed at the Competitions Committee meeting.

Mike Smith commented on progress towards the Cornhusker Classic I & II. The Competition Committee will be meeting Wednesday, March 16, 2011, at Dino's in Lincoln. The application for the USEF Jr/YR qualifying classes is going before the USEF dressage committee for possible approval this week. Amy will notify the Board of the status of the application.

Mike will be investigating registering the Cornhusker Classic I & II with the AQHA so Quarter Horse owners can utilize the recognized show for points.

The Shaggy Horse Show request for NDA recognition has been received. The recognition had been previously approved pending receiving the request.

Awards: Amy proposed offering a year end award for Western Dressage. Felice offered to donate the award, Gillian offered to

donate ribbons. Amy moved to accept this proposal, Gillian seconded. Motion carried.

Updated awards were presented. There have been some changes, and these updates will now go to the awards committee to be presented to the respective members.

Communications: It was suggested that a hard copy of The Contact be sent to the NDA corporate sponsors.

Publicity: Loye Jaeger sent her report from the Horse Expo to Sydney, and it was forwarded to the Board. Attendance was down this year. Several people who show Quarter Horses stopped by the booth to inquire about receiving points at the Cornhusker Classic I & II. This is addressed under "Competitions". People were also seeking information about Western Dressage. This is also addressed under "Competitions".

Fund Raising: Heidi will be recruiting class sponsorships for the Cornhusker Classic I & II. Gillian has contacted Smart Pak and Grand Meadows about donations for the Classic. Heidi will contact Cosequin and KV Vet Supply.

Equipment Management: The dressage arenas are still being stored at Lincoln Equestrian Center.

JR/YR: Casey was unable to attend the meeting, but Amy report that the committee did meet on February 19, and will present their ideas in April.

Education: Discussion commenced about NDA hosting the Region 4 Adult Clinic on November 5 & 6. Diana will investigate what expenses were incurred when NDA last hosted the Adult Clinic in 2007. Lisa is working on a budget. A suitable location was discussed.

OLD BUSINESS: The Board still needs to submit 5-10 questions to Sydney for consideration in a survey for NDA members. Felice will check on providing a 4H annual award.

NEW BUSINESS: Lisa stated that she is having great difficulty filling committee positions. She asked for ideas. Heidi suggested offering one "free" class at an NDA recognized schooling show for volunteering. Diana suggested presenting a certificate signed by the committee chair to people who had volunteered throughout the year. This certificate would be presented at the year-end awards banquet, and could then be sent in with a show entry, good for the aforementioned "free" class. This would be a long-term suggestion.

In the short term, Lisa suggested personal communication asking people to be involved.

The next board meeting will be held April 11, 2011, at Parker's Rib Ranch at 6:30pm in Ashland, NE.

Owners and trainers wishing ride times must contact the rider of the horse. It is the responsibility of the rider to inform show management of any time conflicts as soon as possible after receiving ride times.

**Awards:** Ribbons awarded through 6<sup>th</sup> place.

**Security:** Provided on Thursday night from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.

**Arenas:** **All** performance arenas are indoors, footing composed of sand/clay, separate sand/dirt warm-up and lunging areas. Introductory classes will be ridden in a small arena (20m x 40m). Training tests 1 and 2 may be in a small arena. All other classes will be in a standard arena (20m x 60m). There will be indoor and outdoor warmup, and a separate lunging area.

**Directions:** **From the East:** From I-80 West, take exit 409 for US Hwy 6 toward Waverly. Turn left onto Hwy 6 toward Lincoln for 2.7 miles. Turn left onto 84<sup>th</sup> St, continue for approximately 1 ½ miles. Turn left onto Havelock Ave or into the Event Center from 84<sup>th</sup> St. **From the West:** From I-80 East, take exit 405 for 56<sup>th</sup> St/US Hwy 77. Turn right onto N 56<sup>th</sup> St, continue to Cornhusker Hwy (T-intersection). Turn left onto Cornhusker Hwy, continue over the bridge to 84<sup>th</sup> St. Turn right onto 84<sup>th</sup> St and continue approximately 1 ½ miles. Turn left onto Havelock Ave or into the Event Center from 84<sup>th</sup> St.



**Other:** Concessions: Available indoors on the grounds, open during show hours. Dogs: Dogs must be leashed and attached to a person at all times. Management may assess a fine if leash rule is not complied with.

**Attire:** Riding jackets are optional. Neat, solid polo shirts or blouses with long or short sleeves (not sleeveless) must be worn tucked in. Riding boots or paddock boots required. ASTM/SEI-certified helmet required for juniors.

**Venue:** Lancaster Event Center offers an abundance of parking for trailers and spectators. RV hookups and indoor showers are available. Performance arenas are all indoors in Kiser-designed arenas and dirt/sand footing. Separate warm-up and lunging areas will be available. **NO bikes, scooters or four-wheelers are allowed around the buildings or in the campground.**

**Effective March 1, 2011, for dressage: Anyone mounted on a horse must wear protective headgear except those riders age 18 and over while on horses that are competing *only* in FEI levels and tests at the Prix St. Georges level and above.**

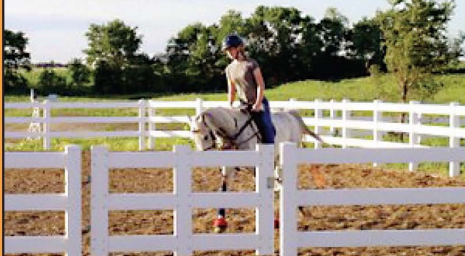
