Entries: \$18.00/test Intro-Second Levels. \$22.00/test for Third and Fourth level. \$25.00/test for Musical Freestyle test of choice. This includes Quadrille and Pas de deux. Members are to split the cost of the entry fee. Freestyle riders will be given a sound check on Friday evening or early on Saturday morning. Please bring multiple copies of music. \$5.00 for Dressage Equitation. Equitation is a group class and may or may not include a small pattern. \$10.00 office fee per horse rider combination. One entry form for each horse/rider combination. Please limit entries to 3 tests per day on each horse, however dressage equitation nor Freestyle count towards the limit. \$15 for post entries if management allows. All entries must have a current NEGATIVE COGGINS test. Make checks payable to NEAT and mail to Show Secretary as listed above.

Refunds: Up to closing date all fees refunded except office fee. After Closing date, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled. During day of competition, no refunds of any kind. The office fee is never refundable.

Times: Ride times will be emailed to competitors 4 days before the show date. Ride times can be mailed with an enclosed SASE if email is not available.

Awards: Ribbons to sixth place for each test and division. High score prize for each division. Worst score aware and Judge's award all to be given.

Stabling: Stalls with doors are available for \$15.00 per stall. Bedding available for purchase at \$6.50 per bag. Tack stalls are \$5.00 per stall.

Directions: I-80 to East GI Exit (HWY 2/34); Go north on spur road for approx. 2 miles to HWY 34, turn left (west) on HWY 34. Continue to Stuhr Road (Fonner Park sign) turn right. Continue past the golf course and turn left on East Stolley Park Rd. Fonner Park and the Heartland Event Center will be on your right.

Accommodations: RV hook-ups available for \$15.00 per night. Oak Grove 308-384-1333, Super 8 308-384-4380, Holiday Inn 308-384-1330, Budget Host 308-382-1815, Travel Lodge 308-382-5003

Footings: Competition arena is indoors with sand footing. Multiple outdoor arenas with sand footing. Management reserves the right to use a shortened, standard dressage arena for competition. Separate lunging arenas available with sand footing.

Concessions: Possibly available on grounds. Many restaurants within close proximity.

Management Rules and Regulations: All dogs must be on leashes. Show management reserves the right use the small arena for Intro and Training level. Indoor competition arena may be a shortened, standard arena. Management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes if entries warrant. Management reserves the right to refuse entries. Competition arena will be available for schooling from 7-9 pm the evening before competition and for 1 hour prior to the start of competition. Non-competition horses are allowed on grounds, but must fill out an entry form and pay \$10.00 office fee.
