Directions from Omaha: I-80 West to Highway 77 South. Exit 77 South onto VanDorn heading west. Left/South on Coddington 1.5 miles to W. Claire Ave. Right/West on W. Claire Travel .02 mile and turn left/South at LEC sign. Parking shall be designated. Directions from Beatrice: Highway 77 North to Denton Road West. Turn right/North on Coddington. Travel 1.5 miles to W. Claire Avenue. Turn left/West on W. Claire and travel .02 miles and turn left/South at LEC sign.

REGISTRATION: Entry opening date is April 18, 2007 and entry closing date is May 18, 2007.
Payment in full must accompany entry form. **FEES:** \$15/class (\$5 for class #s 6, 7 & 8; \$1 for class # 9); \$5 office fee. **Refunds** (less \$10 office fee) for cancellation received before closing date. After closing date, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled. No refunds due to acts of nature. Mail SIGNED entry form and check to Show Secretary. All riders must check in with show office prior to first ride. **Make checks payable to LEC and mail to Show Manager/Secretary as listed above.**

RIDE TIMES: Times will be emailed to riders or mailed. If you wish to have your ride time mailed, please enclose a self-addressed and stamped envelope. Ride times will be mailed approximately 4 days before the show.

LIMITATIONS: One entry form for each horse/rider combination. Three rides per horse/rider combination per day, six rides per horse per day, four total rides per rider per day (exception for class #s 6, 7, 8 & 9). All entries must have a current NEGATIVE COGGINS test – please mail copy with registration to Show Secretary.

AWARDS AND RULES: Ribbons will be awarded through sixth place. Champion and Reserve Champion awards for high average in Intro, Training and Advanced levels. In order to qualify for Champion and Reserve Champion awards, competitor must ride two tests from level, one of which must be the highest test in the level. Current USA Equestrian and USDF tests will be used. Attire appropriate for schooling shows is expected. Show is NDA approved and will adhere to NDA equipment requirements. Improper equipment may be grounds for elimination. Please check with Show Manager if you are unsure of equipment requirements.

STALLS AND ACCOMODATIONS: If you would like a stall, send a separate check for the stall(s). Indicated what day(s)/evening(s) you are reserving. We will return your check if we cannot accommodate you. Friday to Saturday - \$40, Saturday to Sunday - \$40, Friday to Sunday - \$60, Single Day - \$25. One horse per stall. Stalls include one bag of bedding per day. Additional bedding may be purchased from LEC at \$6.50 per bag. No discount for tack stalls.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions will be available both days.

ARENAS: Short arena will be used for Intro and Training Level Tests 1 and 2. Warm-up will be in indoor arena or on grass.

OTHER: Lungeing in designated areas only. Management reserves the right to combine or cancel classes. Well-mannered dogs on leashes welcome. HELMETS must be worn by all riders at all times when mounted.

COMPETITOR PARTY: LEC will host a Competitor Party barbeque the evening of Saturday, June 2, shortly following the last class of the day. Admission is free to all competitors and to volunteers. Guest tickets may be purchased for \$5 per person (no advance purchase necessary).
