We will schedule horse/rider combinations in small groups. Each rider will be allowed to ride 2 tests. Each group will have an assigned time to arrive, with riders leaving immediately after they complete their tests. We will rotate groups throughout the day, allowing you time to tack up your horse and warm up. Trailers will be spaced with plenty of distance between. Classes will be split, and results and placings will be posted online at the end of the day. Tests and ribbons will be mailed.

Stabling is Jump Out. Call Linda if you need a pen for your horse.

Attire: Attire appropriate for Schooling Shows is expected. Neat Polo shirts or blouses with long or short sleeves (not sleeveless) must be worn tucked in, Western Attire is expected for WDAA Classes. Riding boots or paddock boots are required. Helmets are required for all riders, no exceptions.
