 - Saturday 6:00 am – 7:00 pm (Pav. 2 closes @ 3:30 pm for Breed show)
 - Sunday 5:00 am – 3:00 pm (Pav. 2 closed until 9:30 am for Breed show)
- Show office hours are:
 - Thursday - 2 - 7 PM
 - Friday 7 AM - 7 PM
 - Saturday 7 AM - 6:30 PM
 - Sunday 6:30 AM - end of show.
 - All tests will be ridden in the standard/large arena. Ride times may change and www.horseshowoffice.com has the latest information.
- Amy Countryman (Pavilion 4) is only available for hand walking around the arena Saturday and Sunday until 7:30 am
- Designated Lunging area is Pavilion 3, available Thursday 2:00 – 7:00 pm, Friday 6:00 am – 8:00 pm , Saturday 6:00 am – 6:00 pm and Sunday 5:00 am – 3:00 pm.
- Good Times Grill (near the show office) will be open during show hours for all services.
 - USEF's COVID guidelines do not require concessions to be open, but we hope you'll take advantage of the convenience!
- The General Store (for shavings) is located in the stalling area will be open 5:00 – 9:00 pm Thursday & Friday for food, drinks, camping and extra shavings.
