On Sunday May 5, 2019, the day following the Spring Fling Dressage Schooling Show at the same location, our judge, Marie Maloney, will be offering 45 minute Clinic rides. We will be accepting a limited number of private and/or semi-private rides. Priority, and a special 4-H/Pony Club rate, will be given to youth riders.

Adult rides will be \$60 for private and \$40 for semi-private. 4-H/Pony Clubbers rides will be able to ride at no charge! We may schedule semi-private rides to maximize the number of participants.
