Please describe in 500 words (or less) the following points:

- Demonstrate your dedication and commitment to the sport of dressage and the Nebraska Dressage Association (hours of volunteering, involvement in local events, clubs, etc.).
- Describe how you will benefit from attending the event you wish your scholarship funds to cover. Include long term and short term goals.
- How does this event promote wellness of horse and rider in the sport of dressage?
- Briefly describe your financial plan, including costs of event, lodging, etc. and how you plan to use the scholarship money.
- Why should you receive the scholarship? Are you willing to participate or organize clinics? Do you have any ideas how to give back to the association?

Please email your completed scholarship application to the following address no later than **May 1st**. The NDA Board of directors will review your application and winners will be announced May 15th.
