Attire: Informal attire is encouraged, but must have collar and sleeves while mounted. Neat Polo Shirts or blouses for English Dressage and Western Attire as stated by WDAA for Western. Riding boots or paddock boots are required. Helmets are required for all riders, no exceptions.

Current 2020 USDF & WDAA Tests will be used.
